Dear Whites Chapel Cemetery Association members and friends,

Another year is closing of our oversight and care for our common interest in the revered resting place for so many of our departed family and dear friends. You have done a remarkable job of supporting the continuing efforts to maintain this much beloved property.

Major proposed changes to WCCA bylaws will be presented for your consideration and possible approval at our next annual meeting and for endorsement of a new slogan for WCC. The new slogan that will be presented "An Historic Treasure in the Heart of Southlake." We send memorial letters, fund raising appeals, thank you letters to merchants who supply refreshments for our work days in the cemetery and it is one person's opinion that a slogan carries meaning for the tens of thousands of residents that have come to live in Southlake over these past two decades.

It has been my un-heralded objective to achieve at least one major improvement and beautification project every year You were so gracious and thoughtful to contribute to the beautiful wrought iron and Austin stone fence. After the big snow storm three years ago you turned out in support of our cemetery work day and clean-up. Then came the Boy Scouts with the monument cleaning project and they followed with the project to place seating in the property for rest, prayer and meditation.

This past year you approved a \$3000.00 monument repair item in our 2012 operating budget for monument resetting and leveling. Over 25 properties in the cemetery benefitted from that project. We yet have over a hundred more monuments that need attention. Our secretary/treasurer, Roger Hays, has carried the load for executing these projects and for seeing that our suppliers are paid on time.

Now to go from the sublime to the ridiculous, some monuments are in a near terminal state and need to be placed in hospice care. If you know of such a service (monument hospice care) please give notice and you will be given editorial credit for your miraculous find.

Roger, working with my son, Alan, has a phone system that provides a direct connection to your Association's President for all incoming contacts. The total cost is in the neighborhood of \$30.00 per year and no monthly bill. The purpose is to reroute the cemetery number to any person elected to the office of President. Due to the physical condition of many of our members, distant addresses, and advancing ages; I have long dreamed of a cadre of volunteers who may have no heritage interest in WCC but want to help our preservation effort by such things as fund raising, cemetery maintenance, and raising media and community support. I have made overtures to 8 or 10 prospective volunteers to serve as "Friends of Whites Chapel Cemetery." All responses have been positive but, as yet, nothing has happened.
